



Rules for Preliminary Online Contest (Kanpur Site)

About Preliminary Contest:

The Preliminary Online Contest for the selection of the teams for the onsite contest to be held in Kanpur on 23 -24 December 2024 has been scheduled on **Saturday, 16 November, 2024**. All teams desiring to participate at the ICPC Kanpur Site Contest must register and participate in this online contest. Because of the limited number of available slots in Kanpur Site Contest, we have decided the following:

- The Online contest will be open to all teams who have completed the registration formalities.
- Participation is mandatory for all teams aiming for selection in the Kanpur onsite contest.
- Only top few teams with better performance in the online contest will be advanced for the Kanpur Onsite contest.

Online Contest Rules:

- The contest will be conducted over the Internet.
- Teams whose registration formalities are completed are only eligible to participate in the contest.
- In case plagiarism is detected in any team's submission, all teams from the respective institute/s will be blacklisted, disqualifying them from participation in any regional site of India for the onsite competition.
- You are not allowed to discuss strategy, suggestions or tips in the comments with anyone other than contestants of your team during the contest.
- Organizing Institute will not be responsible in case any program does not work at our environment. So, try to use one of the mentioned compiler versions.
- Judges' decision will be treated as final. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- Kanpur Site will not be responsible for any internet failure during the contest at the contestants' site.
- Each participating team must submit solutions during the contest period.
- Selection of Teams may or may not reflect the Ranking of the Teams.

Note: There will be a single Preliminary Online Contest for all three Regional Sites in India (i.e., Kanpur, Amritapuri, and Chennai). Each regional site will prepare its own rank list based on the teams registered for that site from the Preliminary Online Contest rankings. Teams participating in multiple regional sites are requested to keep the same team members for each Regional Site.

Selection Procedure for On-site Contest:

- There are 105 slots available for the Onsite contest, where 100 slots are General slots and 05 slots are kept for “all female teams”.
- Selection Criteria is as follows:

Selection in General Slot

1. Discard all teams who could not solve a single problem.
2. Rank all teams based on the performance in the Preliminary Round.
3. Select top 15 (fifteen) ranked teams for Onsite Contest.
4. Remove these 15 teams from the Rank List
5. Select the top ranked team from each distinct school or institute.
6. Arrange all these top ranked teams with respect to their performance in the Preliminary Round.
7. Select teams from the top as long as the all General slots are available and the list is not exhausted.
8. In case it is found that the number of selected teams in this process is less than the available General slots, remove selected teams from the Rank List and repeat step 5.

Selection in All Female Slot

The 5 reserved slots for Women's Teams will be filled in a similar manner after selecting 100 teams for the General Slots (i.e., selecting the best all women's team from each institute).

All female Team: *A team consisting entirely of female contestants. The gender of the coach does not need to be female. Slots for such "All Female Teams" are reserved to encourage and promote the participation of female contestants in the ICPC.*

Clarification: *In case a team consist of only 02 contestants and both are female, will it be considered as "All female team"?*

Answer: *Yes, even the same is true for single contestant team.*
